2. Issues to be addressed:

1) Background

With the rapid rise of China and the relative decline of the U.S. influence, there is a concern about the destabilization in the Indo-Pacific, and the cooperation between India and Japan is of increasing importance.

- 2) Interests shared by India and Japan with respect to China
 - (1) Economic Importance:Biggest Trading Partner and Competitor
 - (2) Political/Military Caution:

Territorial land, territorial waters, and territorial airspace are all flashpoints, and there is a concern about China's increasing international influence. Given this situation, it is essential that we strengthen the India-Japan cooperation, deepen coordination with ASEAN countries, avoid conflicts and co-exist with China.

(3) "Japan and India Special Strategic and Global Partnership":

Although the importance of the India-Japan partnership is often emphasized, there is an urgent need to materialize/accelerate the partnership.
