

Workshop on Researching Oral Histories and Important Documents Related to Fiscal Policy

Subject	Investigate historical turning points in public finance (using an interview format) and collect and store important financial documents.
Overview	Conduct interviews of former government officials, et al. (e.g.,former vice-ministers, directors-general, et al.) involved in historical turning points in public finance, taking the interviews down as oral history, and establish a committee of experts (such as administrative officials with practical experience in financial administration), aiming at the selection, collection and preservation of important fiscal-related documents, particularly those related to social security, comprehensive tax reform and qualitative/ quantitative monetary easing.
