# Society of Security and Diplomatic Policy Studies

With China becoming a superpower and a power transition taking place in the Asia-Pacific region, this study group debated, analyzed, and conducted research centered on Japan's relations with countries in the region on a continuing, multilayered basis from the standpoint of national security and foreign policy, and conducted research on commission in order to make policy recommendations.
